
Ad Hoc Press Release – Framing Black and White Images

In Store Events – Children's Frame Design

This involves linking with a local school to run a competition for the children to design their own frames. Each child would receive a bare wood frame which they can customise any way they want. This offers a fantastic photo opportunity for the local media.

This type of event works as a way of generating visitors to store, a good example of CSR in your local community and strengthening links and contacts with the local school which may generate further business.
